- The RHA Entitlement Certificate is valid for two (2) years:
 - → Applicants with **pending** residence permit applications and holding an **official acknowledgement letter/Interim Receipt** are issued with a Provisional Certificate valid for **one (1) year**.

- Fill in and sign the application form. Please ensure all filled-in information is **correct**.
